Distribution One

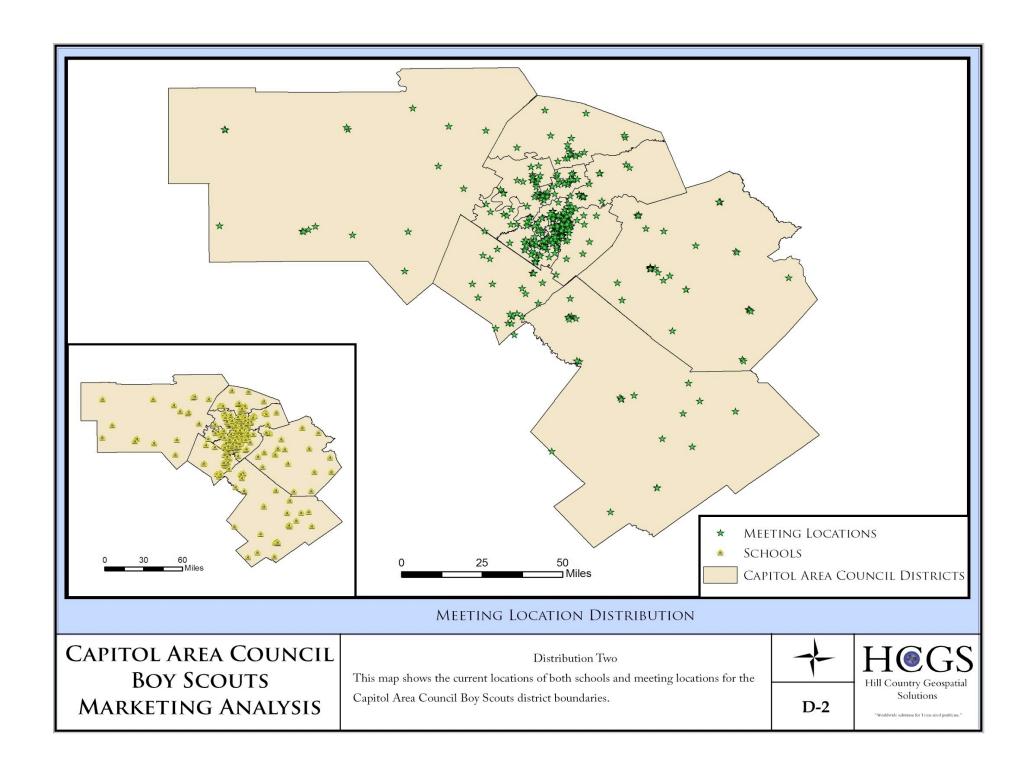
This map indicates the current location, density and distribution of Cub Scout members in the Capitol Area Council Boy Scout districts.

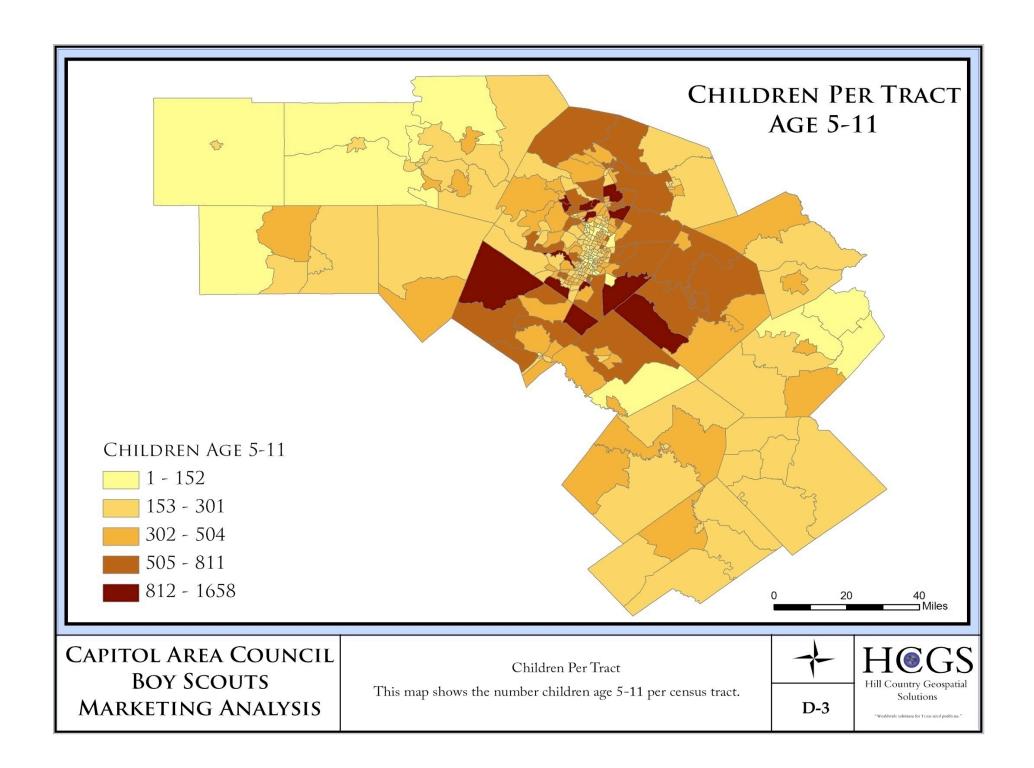


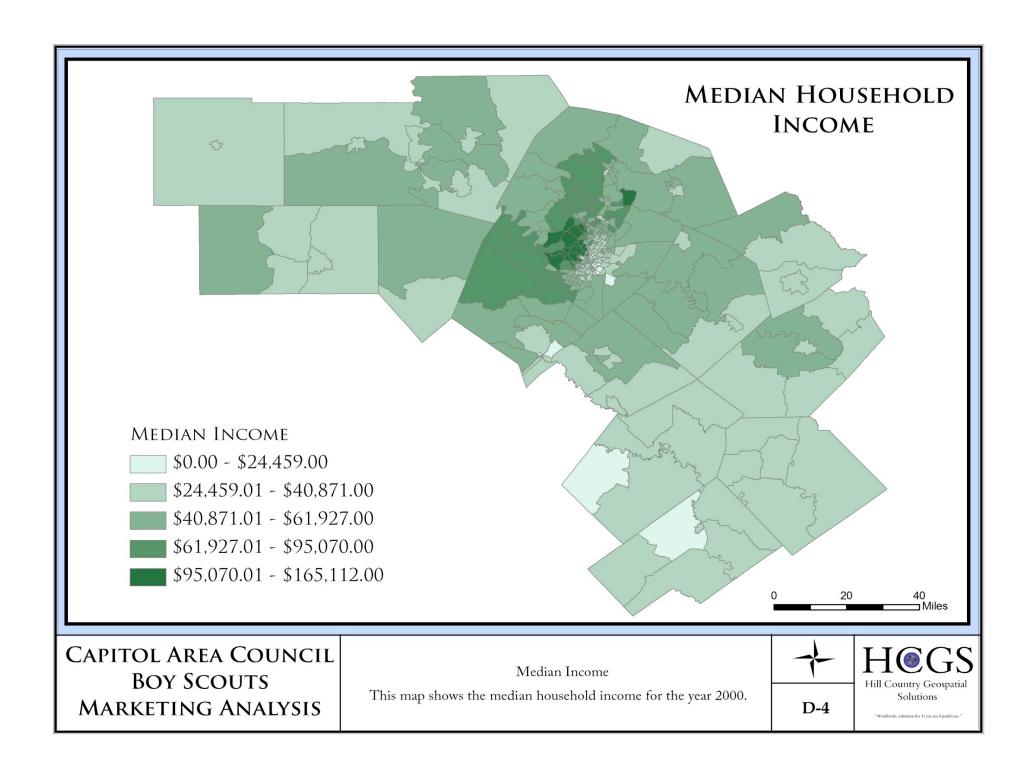
